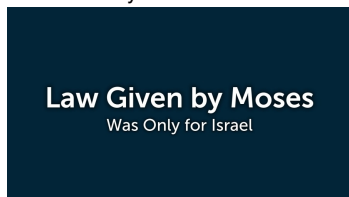


God has given various laws to mankind through the ages. One of these was given by Moses, what we know as the Old
